SEMI-ANNUAL SQUAD REPORT: (see attached report)

Sheriff Staley reported his department does a good job of staying within budget confines. He has not utilized general fund money for squad car rotation this year. Crime Stoppers has graciously & generously given money to the MCSO for one new squad. Two Missouri squads have also been purchased using MCSO special funds.

SHERIFF'S REPORTS:

The Mercer County Sheriff's reports for the month of May 2017 were presented for review and discussion. The jail census for today is: USMS=17; Mercer County=14; Cook County=25. The transition with Cook County has gone very well and will see how another month goes before accepting additional inmates.

OTHER BUSINESS:

The next Law Enforcement meeting is Wednesday, July 19, 2017, 9:00 a.m. at the Annex.

The Sheriff stated he will be attending a meeting tomorrow in Macomb discussing the possibility regarding a 911 dispatching contract service for Mercer County. Sheriff Staley is not supporting this idea for the risk & safety factors involved for his deputies, dispatch, and citizens of Mercer County. This may be a good concept to consolidate counties that have multiple 911 centers. The risks will not outweigh the cost savings and our 911 tax money would be required to go toward the contract dispatching service entity. Sheriff Staley also researched legislation regarding this and found out there is legislation requiring multiple 911 centers within a county to consolidate for a county population of 250,000 or more. There will be expenses for the MCSO regarding 911 changes and/or updates in the near future, but these are things that can be managed and planned in advance.

In other business:

- the Sheriff reported the Mercer County Fair will be coming soon & the new TRIAD program will have a booth at the fair to inform & sign people up who could benefit from this service
- he also informed the committee that our new visitation system works great with Cook County inmates; family members can skype visit from 9 am to 9 pm so they do not have to visit in person
